Fees include:

- \$225 Barrow or Gilt
 - \$125 Facility Use and Basic Medication Fees
 - AMP Proxy Tag, Pens, feed trough, waters, zip ties, medications if needed, etc.
 - Student FFA Dues
 - ~\$200 Feed
 - ~\$300 Supplies
 - \$20 Show Entry Fee
- Total Fees = ~\$850

Amount Due to JM FFA Booster Club=\$20
Amount Due to AMP=\$125

A \$50 deposit (non-refundable) is due to Mrs. Cooper by May 6th. This deposit tentatively reserves a spot for you in the barn. When all fees have been paid in full on or before May 20th, only then have you solidified a spot in the barn. The Livestock Project Priority System will be used if needed (page 11 of AMP Livestock Feeding Guidelines).

These deposits and fees are to be paid to Mrs. Cooper in person on May 6th & May 20th (EXACT cash or check made payable to James Madison FFA). Payments must be paid in person to Mrs. Cooper in the AMP Office. Do NOT mail in payments.

The following is a brief list of reminders for this year's swine projects:

- Project Duration
 - ~4 months
 - Feeding/caring every morning and afternoon
- Students will receive their swine mid-June (Date-TBD).
- Swine Camp
 - We will have two informational/work camp dates set for June 22 & 23 from 9:00a.m. – 4:00p.m. (**\$20 AMP Livestock Expo entry fee will be due at one of these meetings. Cash or check made payable to JM FFA Booster Club.**)
 - Students may be asked to bring a sack lunch both days.
 - These two camp days are **MANDATORY**. Students will learn how to care for their show pigs, set up their AET (record books) and set-up/clean the swine barn.
 - Student will need to dress in school appropriate attire. This attire must also be appropriate for working outside.

All JV swine (AMP Livestock Expo Swine) will be acquired by Ms. Molitor. This rule is intended to make sure that all pigs are of the same blood lines and students start on as much of an equal playing field as possible.

- May 20th: Fees due to AMP
- June 22 & 23: JV Swine Camp (**Attendance is MANDATORY**)
- Mid-June (TBD): Pigs Arrive (**Attendance is MANDATORY**)
- October 22nd: AMP Livestock Expo (**Attendance is MANDATORY**)
- October 29th: Barn Clean-Up (**Attendance is MANDATORY**)
